Amendment in Mukhya Mantri Khadyanna Sahayata Yojna

Chhattisgarh Mukhya Mantri Khadyanna Sahayata Yojna was published in the Chhattisgarh Gazette (Extraordinary) dated 23rd February 2007 vide Notification No. F-4/Food/07/20, Raipur dated 23rd February 2007 for information of public. This scheme is amended as follows: -

- 1. The consumer selling price of rice for Saffron, 10 Kg Saffron, and Gray ration card holders under Mukhya Mantri Khadyanna Sahayata Yojna and Yellow ration card holders of BPL scheme under Targeted Public Distribution System will be Rs 3 per Kg from 1st January 2008.
- 2. Rice is being distributed at Rs 3 per Kg to Red ration card holders of Antyodaya scheme. They will continue to get rice at the same rate.
- 3. The consumer selling price of rice for other ration card holders will remain unchanged.
- 4. Chhattisgarh State Civil Supplies Corporation will have to procure large quantities of rice at economic cost because Central Government has reduced the allocation of APL food grains for Chhattisgarh. Therefore payment of the difference in amount for Mukhya Mantri Khadyanna Sahayata Yojna will be made to the Chhattisgarh State Civil Supplies Corporation from 1st April 2007 on the following principles:
 - a. Since APL rice received from Government of India will be distributed to white ration card holder APL families at APL rates no difference in amount will be payable for this distribution.
 - b. Since Antyodaya rice received from Government of India will be distributed to Red ration card holder Antoydaya families at Antyodaya rates no difference in amount will be payable for this distribution.
 - c. Rice is received from Government of India at BPL rates for Yellow ration card holder BPL familes. Since rice will be distributed to these families at BPL rates from 1st April 2007 to 31st December 2007, no difference in amount will be payable for this period. Since Yellow ration card holders will be distributed rice at Rs 3 per Kg from 1st January 2008, therefore the difference in amount between BPL Central issue price and 3 rupees will be payable to the State Civil Supplies Corporation by the State Government for the rice distributed to these Yellow ration card holders from 1st January 2008. In addition incidental expenditure, commission and transportation cost fixed by the State Government from time to time shall also be payable from 1st January 2008 to the State Civil Supplies Corporation, from which State Civil Supplies Corporation will pay transportation cost and commission to the lead organizations and commission to Fair Price Shops.
 - d. Some Saffron and 10 Kg Saffron ration card holders of Mukhya Mantri Khadyanna Sahayata Yojna have been distributed rice from the APL rice received from Government of India and rest of them have been distributed rice from the rice procured by Chhattisgarh State Civil Supplies Corporation at economic cost. Therefore the principles for payment of the difference in amount for these shall be as follows: -
 - One. The difference in amount between APL central issue price and BPL central issue price will be payable for the quantity of rice

- which is distributed from 1st April 2007 to 31st December 2007 from the APL rice received from Government of India.
- Two. The difference in amount between APL central issue price and 3 rupees will be payable for the quantity of rice which is distributed from 1st January 2008 from the APL rice received from Government of India.
- Three. The difference in amount between Economic cost and BPL central issue price will be payable for the quantity of rice which is distributed from 1st April 2007 to 31st December 2007 from the rice procured by the State Civil Supplies Corporation at Economic Cost.
- Four. The difference in amount between Economic cost and 3 rupees will be payable for the quantity of rice which is distributed from 1st January 2008 from the rice procured by the State Civil Supplies Corporation at Economic Cost.
- Five. In addition incidental expenditure, commission and transportation cost fixed by the State Government from time to time shall also be payable from 1st January 2008 to the State Civil Supplies Corporation, from which State Civil Supplies Corporation will pay transportation cost and commission to the lead organizations and commission to Fair Price Shops.
- e. Some gray ration card holders of Mukhya Mantri Khadyanna Sahayata Yojna have been distributed rice from the APL rice received from Government of India some from BPL rice received from Government of India and rest of them have been distributed rice from the rice procured by Chhattisgarh State Civil Supplies Corporation at economic cost. Therefore the principles for payment of the difference in amount for these shall be as follows: -
 - One. The difference in amount between APL central issue price and 3 rupees will be payable for the quantity of rice which is distributed from 1st April 2007 from the APL rice received from Government of India.
 - Two. The difference in amount between BPL central issue price and 3 rupees will be payable for the quantity of rice which is distributed from 1st April 2007 from the BPL rice received from Government of India.
 - Three. The difference in amount between Economic Cost and 3 rupees will be payable for the quantity of rice which is distributed from 1st April 2007 from the rice procured by State Civil Supplies Corporation at Economic Cost.
 - Four. In addition incidental expenditure, commission and transportation cost fixed by the State Government from time to time shall also be payable from 1st April 2007 to the State Civil Supplies Corporation, from which State Civil Supplies Corporation will pay transportation cost and commission to the lead organizations and commission to Fair Price Shops.
- f. State Civil Supplies Corporation shall submit information to the State Government for claims for payment of the difference in amount in a format fixed by the Director.
